Welcome to Bridge Clinic

The doctors within this group practice have a broad range of experience and expertise and provide a full range of medical services and care.

You are encouraged to choose your own family doctor. All doctors consult by appointment and most undertake inpatient care at Murray Bridge Soldiers Memorial Hospital.

Appointments

Are available with a wide range of doctors. Appointments are up to 15 minutes long. If you consider that a longer appointment is required, please discuss this with the receptionist when you make your appointment. Medicals, removal of lesions, chronic disease and mental health care plan preparation are examples of when a longer appointment is required. Please notify us immediately if you are unable to keep your appointment. We require four hours notice for cancellation or a fee may apply.

Emergency Doctor

Emergency doctors are always available for urgent problems without prior appointment. Emergencies (including ambulance cases) will be given priority, otherwise patients will be seen in order of presentation.

After Hours: Emergency treatment or advice can be obtained by phoning the hospital on **8535 6777** or attending the hospital. Bridge Clinic GPs provide emergency care at the Murray Bridge Hospital.

Home Visits: Are available to regular patients only and at the discretion of their treating doctor. Charges will apply.

Obstetrics: Doctors M.Altmann, Butler, Carr, Rischbieth, Valerio, Wagner, Gebler-Hughes and Wild practice obstetric care, providing ante-natal care at the clinic and delivering babies at the hospital.

Repeat Prescriptions: Best medical care recommends that you make an appointment to discuss your medication before being issued with a repeat prescription. Only in special circumstances will our doctors issue a prescription without a consultation. A fee will be charged on collection of script.

Test Results

Patients are encouraged to make a follow up appointment with their doctor for test results. Your GP will inform you on how you will receive your test results.

Accounts

FEES - In Clinic Consultations:

Bulk billed services available for pensioners, concession card holders and children under 16 for consultation in clinic hours.

Other fees charged for professional services are available in our Accounts Information brochure.

Accounts are to be paid in full on the day of your appointment. A discount will be applied for full payment on the day.

Medicare claims are transferred electronically and the rebate deposited directly into the bank account of your choice within 3 days.

We accept payment by cash, EFTPOS, direct debit (direct debit details are provided below), personal cheque or credit card.

A facility fee (not claimable from Medicare) is charged for complex dressings and procedures. All concession/DVA card holders please present cards at check-in.

FEES - After Hours Consultations:

Any service after hours will incur a gap payment.

Pensioners and concession card holders receive a reduced rate on after hours accounts. A discount on all after hours accounts will be applied if the gap is paid within the 14 day period.

Extra charges apply to any procedure performed during after hours visits.

Interpreter

Phone service is available on request. Please notify staff if you need an interpreter.

Visiting Specialists: We have a comprehensive range of specialists who attend Bridge Clinic on a regular basis and operate at Murray Bridge Hospital. Referral from your own doctor is required. Please see our staff or our website for a full list.

Referrals are routinely sent by secure message service or fax prior to your appointment.

Bridge Clinic is not responsible for the fee setting and collection of our visiting specialists. If you have any queries regarding your specialist account, please contact the specialist concerned.

Medical History: Please book an appointment to see your GP to complete forms requiring your patient information or medical history. Examples of these are: Pension applications; Sickness Benefit application; Passport application; Document Witness application. Please note that not all of these items attract a Medicare rebate and payment may be required on the day.
